

**CUT BANK CITY COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 6, 2017
6:30 P.M. – CITY HALL**

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Mayor Raemaeker called the meeting of the Cut Bank City Council to order at 6:30 PM, Monday, November 6, 2017. The following Council members answered roll call: Councilpersons Tim Curtiss, Donovan Grubb (via telephone), and Tim Kipp. Also present were City Clerk-Treasurer Linda Burley, City Superintendent Jim Suta, City Attorney Robert Smith and Police Chief Schultz. All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

ABSENT: none**VISITORS:** Erik Nelson, Diana Gobert

CLAIMS: Councilperson Kipp moved to approve the claims through November 2, 2017 for \$1,063,068.79. Councilperson Curtiss seconded the motion and the motion carried with a 3-0 vote.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION: Annual Christmas Party has been scheduled for December 9, 2017 at the Elk's.

CONSENT AGENDA:

Councilperson Curtiss moved to approve the City Council Minutes from October 2, 2017 and the October 5, 2017 payroll in the amount of \$79,831.86, the October 19, 2017 payroll for \$74,266.62, the November 2, 2017 payroll for \$70,470.42, and financials for July (\$5,761,552.08), August (\$5,687,516.83), and September (\$5,818,973.10). Councilperson Kipp seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:

Superintendent Suta presented his monthly report. **He will be placing information on our snow plowing policy in the Pioneer Press, along with plow routes, schedules, and rules about shoveling sidewalks. Councilperson Kipp moved to accept the report and Councilperson Curtiss seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.**

OLD BUSINESS: None.**NEW BUSINESS:**

Councilperson Curtiss moved to approve Wade Jacobson to move ahead with his request to get a conditional use permit for The Den. Councilperson Grubb seconded the motion and it passed 3-0.

Councilperson Curtiss moved to accept the proposed rank structure for the Cut Bank Police Department. Councilperson Kipp seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Councilperson Grubb moved to approve Draw #5 of the SRF-18614 in the amount of \$438,005.00. Councilperson Curtiss seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

Correspondence: Letter of resignation from Tyson Michaels. Councilperson Michaels has moved out of town. Councilperson Kipp moved to accept the resignation. Councilperson Curtiss seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
